Candidates for the Associate Infant/Toddler Credential must complete all requirements for the program in which they are enrolled, and may not represent themselves as holding an Infant/Toddler Credential. Holders of the Associate Infant/Toddler Credential are strongly encouraged to submit proof that they are in process toward attaining their 4-year college degree. Teachers with an Associate Credential are eligible for the Infant/Toddler Credential when the 4-year college degree requirement has been completed and an official college transcript is sent to the certifying agency.
